Elliott Relocates and Renames Oil Systems Business

Jeannette, PA , April 21, 2009 – Elliott Company has relocated its Packaging Solutions business, formerly known as Elliott Oil Systems, from Donora, Pennsylvania to Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania. The move reflects the growth and expansion of the company's auxiliary systems business which encompasses Elliott oil systems, as well as dry gas seal, steam turbine, compressor, piping and turbine generator packaging.

Prior to the move, the Packaging Solutions business shared space with Elliott's Donora service shop. "Both businesses are growing and we needed more capacity," said Dale Klingensmith, Operations Manager for the Packaging Solutions business. "In addition to our traditional Elliott business, we see opportunity for growth in packaging auxiliary systems for non-Elliott rotating equipment in the power industry - oil, gas and nuclear energy." Examples of non-Elliott auxiliary packages include lube and control oil systems; fuel oil pump packages; fuel forwarding skids; fuel oil and fuel gas valve and water injection skids; and gas turbine manifold and interconnecting piping.

Throughout April, Elliott's Packaging Solutions business will complete projects in process at the Donora facility while starting new work in Belle Vernon. When the transition is complete, the Donora service shop will also have the room it needs to expand.

"With this move, we have more than doubled our square footage for both businesses," said Robert Cross, Elliott's North America Regional Director, Global Service. "We've structured the move to be seamless, with no interruptions in daily production."

The move of Elliott's Packaging Solutions business to Belle Vernon is the first step in an expansion that will also include regional packaging centers in Europe and Asia Pacific. "We package complete auxiliary systems for turbomachinery for customers around the world," said Klingensmith. "We want to make it convenient for our customers to do business with us no matter where they are located."
